AARP (American Association of Retired Persons) is a nonprofit organization whose mission is “to empower people to choose how they live as they age”. Their purpose is to address the needs and interests of people 50 or older,

whether working or retired, living in the United States. The organization has more than 38 million members as of 2018.

The AARP was founded in 1958 by a retired high school principal, Dr. Ethel Percy Andrus, with the goal of promoting productive aging and helping older Americans live life to the fullest. AARP evolved from the National Retired Teachers Association (NRTA), which Dr. Andrus had established in response to the need of retired teachers for health insurance since Medicare was not available until 1965 and private health insurance was not easily accessible for older Americans.

Since its inception, AARP has developed other benefits and programs to serve the elderly community including health care, financial security for the working and retired, long-term care services, and developing communities for the older population. The organization continues to develop and lobby policies that focus on affordability, quality and accessibility of care for their members. ¹
