THE ACADEMY MUSEUM OF MOTION PICTURES Los Angeles, California

The Academy Museum will be the nation's first large-scale museum dedicated entirely to the art, science, craft, business, and history of film. The permanent and rotating exhibits provide an immersive experience for visitors to explore the cultural and creative contributions that Hollywood and the film industry have made around the world.¹

Pritzker-Prize winner Renzo Piano and architecture firm Gensler have restored and reworked the old May Company building at Fairfax and Wilshire. The modern-style department store built in 1939 has been renamed the Saban building and houses a 288-seat cinematheque and spaces for exhibitions, an entire floor devoted to an “Oscars experience,” restaurants, and special events.
