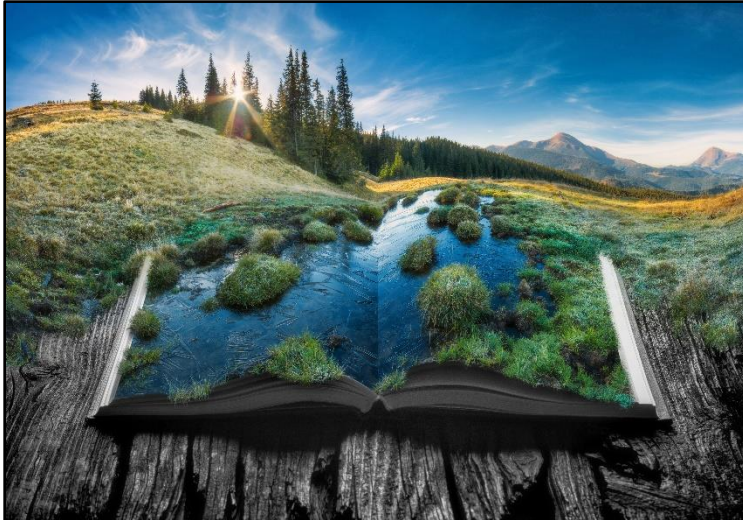

The American Geophysical Union (AGU) is an international nonprofit scientific association of earth, atmospheric, ocean, hydrologic, space,

and planetary scientists with over 60,000 members in 137 countries. AGU's mission is to communicate and promote scientific knowledge and discoveries for a sustainable future for the benefit of humanity.

The organization was established in 1919 by the National Research Council and operated as an unincorporated affiliate of the National Academy of Sciences. AGU was independently incorporated in 1972 and its membership was opened to scientists and students worldwide. Their headquarters building was built in 1994 and was renovated in 2017 with the goals of becoming DC's first net zero energy commercial renovation. AGU strives to be an innovator among scientific organizations by promoting set standards and excellence in scientific research.¹
