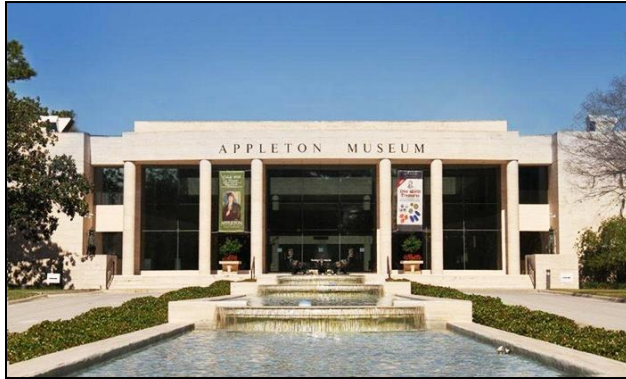

APPLETON MUSEUM OF ART

Ocala, Florida

Appleton Museum of Art is located within the Appleton Cultural Center and is a premier cultural

institution in the South. The 81,610 square ft. space houses a permanent collection of around 18,000 works of art and artifacts of American, European, Asian, African, Contemporary and pre-Columbian cultures and styles. It also displays a collection of works specifically from local Florida artists to represent the history and progression of Central Florida culture.

The museum was founded in 1982 as a gift from Arthur Appleton to the Ocala community, built to display and preserve his extensive art collection. The two-story building made of Italian travertine marble is surrounded by a fountain and a long reflecting pool. The museum also features six art galleries, 250-seat auditorium with state-of-the-art sound equipment, and a courtyard café which can accommodate 150 guests.

The Appleton Museum is a leading cultural center which aspires to bring art and people together to enrich the quality of life for the people of Central Florida and beyond through its wide range of collections, exhibitions, programs and educational opportunities.¹
