The California Air Resources Board (CARB) is a part of the California Environmental Protection Agency, an organization which reports directly to the Governor's Office in

the Executive Branch of California State Government. The mission of the California Air Resources Board is to promote and protect public health, welfare, and ecological resources through the effective and efficient reduction of air pollutants while recognizing and considering the effects on the economy of the state. It is California's lead agency for climate change programs and is charged with protecting the public from the harmful effects of air pollution and developing programs and actions to fight climate change. CARB's major goals are to: provide safe, clean air to all California residents; reduce the state's emission of greenhouse gases; and provide leadership in implementing and enforcing air pollution control rules and regulations. CARB establishes state air quality regulations which protect public health by addressing all major sources of smog-forming air pollution including vehicles, fuels, and consumer products. ¹
