INDIANA UNIVERSITY – PURDUE UNIVERSITY INDIANA Indianapolis, Indiana

Indiana University–Purdue University Indianapolis (IUPUI) is a public research university in Indianapolis. IUPUI, a partnership between Indiana and Purdue universities, is Indiana’s urban research and academic health sciences campus. IUPUI’s “mission is to advance the state of Indiana and the intellectual growth of its citizens to the highest levels nationally and internationally through research and creative activity, teaching and learning, and civic engagement.” IUPUI is an urban campus in Indianapolis, the 15th largest city in the United States, with a population of 2 million in the metropolitan area. IUPUI is home to 30,000 undergraduate, graduate, and professional students from all U.S. states and 145 countries. The university offers more than 350 undergraduate, graduate, and professional programs. ¹

The university is the result of a merger in 1969 of the Purdue Indianapolis Extension Center (1946) and Indiana University Indianapolis (1916). The university hosts the primary campuses for both the Indiana University School of Medicine and the Indiana University School of Dentistry, the only dental school in the state. IUPUI includes the nation’s largest nursing school, the second largest medical school in the country, and the country’s oldest school of physical education. IUPUI is one of seven campuses of Indiana University and includes two Purdue University schools. The campus offers more than 225 degrees provided by 18 different schools. IUPUI is among the top 20 campuses in the nation for graduate professional degrees conferred. ²
