## LAS VEGAS CONVENTION CENTER

Las Vegas, Nevada

The Las Vegas Convention Center (LVCC) is one of the largest convention centers in the world, and it is owned and operated by the Las Vegas

Convention and Visitors Authority (LVCVA). Las Vegas Convention Center encompasses a 4.6 million-square-foot facility with 2.5 million square feet of exhibit space and 225 meeting rooms. The venue hosts events with an estimated 200,000 participants. With Las Vegas being a premier destination for entertainment, business and visitors, the Las Vegas Convention Center is a leading location for meetings and conventions.

The \$1 billion West Hall expansion, opened in June 2021, provides an additional 1.4 million square feet of space including a 14,000-square-foot outdoor terrace with a sweeping view of the Las Vegas Strip. The expansion also introduces the Las Vegas Convention Center Loop, the underground tunnel developed by Elon Musk's The Boring Company designed to shuttle more than 4,400 riders per hour throughout the 200-acre campus in all-electric Tesla vehicles through two-mile-long tunnels. <sup>1</sup>
