MINUTE MAID PARK Houston, Texas

Minute Maid Park opened in 2000 as the home stadium of the Houston Astros of Major League Baseball (MLB). The ballpark is Houston's first retractable-roofed stadium and features a natural grass playing field. Located in the heart of downtown Houston, Minute Maid Park combines the feel of a classic old-time ballpark with the amenities

of a modern stadium. The ballpark was built as a replacement for the Astrodome, the first domed sports stadium ever built, which opened in 1965. The roof at Minute Maid Park, however, retracts completely off the ballpark to reveal the largest open area of any retractable roofed baseball stadium in existence today. The overall seating capacity of Minute Maid Park is 40,963, featuring nine different seating areas providing fans with unique perspectives to the game. ¹
