The New York Times is an American daily newspaper based in New York City with a worldwide readership. It is owned by The New York Times Company, a mass media

and communications company. The New York Times was founded on September 18, 1851, by journalist and politician Henry Jarvis Raymond and former banker George Jones as the New-York Daily Times.<sup>1</sup> In 1896, the hyphen was dropped from the nameplate and became "The New York Times." At The New York Times, their values of independence, integrity, curiosity, respect, collaboration, and excellence guide their journalism to seek the truth and help people understand the world. Since 1851, The New York Times has won 132 Pulitzer Prizes, more than any newspaper. The newspaper has 150 million monthly global readers and 8 million total subscribers, ranking third in circulation in the United States.<sup>2</sup>
