The South Dakota School of Mines & Technology (also known as SD Mines, Rapid Tech, or SDSM&T) is a public university governed by the South Dakota Board of Regents. Its 120-acre campus is located in Rapid City, in the Black Hills of southwestern South Dakota. It was originally founded in 1885 to provide instruction in the region's primary industry of mining. Today the South Dakota School of Mines & Technology has evolved into one of the leading institutions of science and engineering in the region. SD Mines offers degrees in more than 16 engineering and science fields, as well as 12 master's degree programs and 7 Doctorate programs. From geology and mining engineering to particle physics and atmospheric sciences, its students graduate to hold positions as leaders in industry, consulting, government, health, research and education. ¹
