SALEM HOSPITAL Salem, Oregon

Salem Hospital is a non-profit, regional medical center located in Salem, Oregon. It is one of the health care providers of Salem Health, a health system that includes Oregon's award-winning Salem Health main campus in Salem, a

regional referral center; Salem Health West Valley, a critical-access hospital; and Salem Health Medical Group family medicine clinics and specialists. Salem Hospital is one of the largest of Oregon's 62 acute care hospitals and is the area's largest private employer, with more than 4,900 full- and part-time employees. Salem Hospital was founded in 1896 and contains 454 hospital beds and serves an area of about 350,000 people. Salem Hospital operates the busiest emergency department on the West Coast with over 108,000 emergency department visits recorded in 2018.

Salem Hospital is recognized for its award-winning care and has received a high rating in the specialties of pulmonology, urology, diabetes and endocrinology. The hospital also received distinction for high performance in six procedures and conditions including chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, colon cancer surgery, heart bypass surgery, heart failure, hip replacement and knee replacement. The hospital was ranked fourth in the state for its 2018-2019 review of the best regional hospital list by U.S. News & World Report's. ¹
