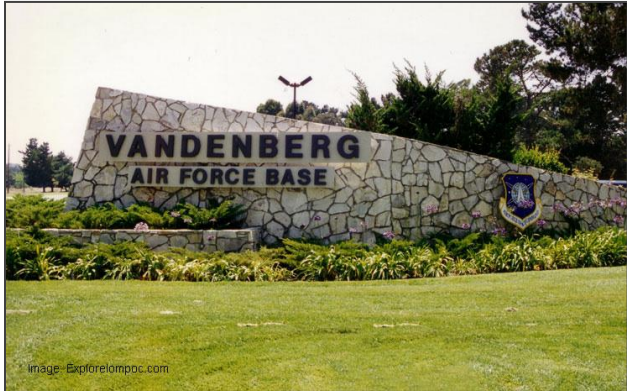

VANDENBERG AIR FORCE BASE Santa Barbara County, CA

Vandenberg Air Force Base is one of the nation's most important military and space installations.

The base is located 9 miles northwest of Lompoc, on the central coast of California, encompassing over 98,000 acres with 35 miles of coastline stretching along the Pacific Ocean.

Vandenberg AFB is a Department of Defense space and missile testing base and the only military base in the United States from which unmanned government and commercial satellites are launched into polar orbit throughout the year. Vandenberg AFB is designated as a closed installation, but monthly visits to the public are managed by its host administrative unit, the 30th Space Wing, the Air Force Space Command organization responsible for all Department of Defense space and missile launch activities on the West Coast. The base supports a population of more than 18,000 military personnel, family members, contractors and civilian employees. ¹
